

A RESOLUTION OF LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for Lincoln County was calculated as 88.008 mills by the Lincoln County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of Lincoln County will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 6, 2022 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Lincoln County, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LINCOLN COUNTY:

The Lincoln County shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 88.008 mills. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.

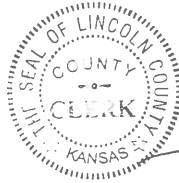
