

FINAL RESOLUTION AND ORDER  
RESOLUTION NO. 2005V-03

Now on this 10th day of October 2005, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, Lincoln County, Kansas, all members of said board being present, the matter of the vacation of certain roads, alleys and platted lands comes on for final hearing and order before said board.

After due consideration, and after being duly advised in the premises, the board finds, that on the 19th day of September, 2005, the said board did unanimously make a preliminary resolution, Resolution 2005R-04, proposing to vacate certain roads, alleys and platted lands, as in their judgement said roads alleys and platted lands are not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes said roads, alleys and platted lands were never developed and the necessity for said roads and alleys as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of necessary funds to develop said roads and alleys for public travel; said roads, alleys and platted lands are as follows:

All that part of the Townsite of Juniata, Kansas lying in the NE1/4 of Section Twenty-Two (22), Township Thirteen (13), Range Six (6) West of the Sixth P.M., more particularly described as: Lots one (1) through twenty (20) in Block one (1), and all of the alleys lying within these lots in Block one (1); Lots one (1) through twenty-one (21) in Block two (2), and all of the alleys lying within these lots in Block two (2); Lots one (1) through seventeen (17) in Block 3, and all of the alleys lying within these lots in Block 3; Lots one (1) through seventeen (17) in Block four (4), and all of the alleys lying in Block four (4)

All that part of the Townsite of Juniata, Kansas lying in the SE1/4 of Section Fifteen (15), Township Thirteen (13), Range Six (6) West of the Sixth P.M., more particularly described as: Lots one (1) through seven (7) in Block 5; Lots one (1) through seventeen (17) in Block six (6), and all alleys lying in Block six (6); Lots one (1) through eight (8) in Block seven (7); Tract 1; and Tract No. 2

All that part of the Townsite of Juniata, Kansas, lying in the SW1/4 of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirteen (13), Range Six (6) West of the Sixth P.M., more particularly described as: Lots one (1) through sixteen (16) in Block eight (8); Lots one (1) through fifteen (15) in Block nine (9).

Also including the streets that border the above Blocks including that part of Charles St, South St, Washington Ave, Johnson Ave and East Ave.

*Railroad St is not vacated as the County has taken it over and it is now known as E Deer Dr. Nebraska Ave is not vacated as the county has taken it over and it is now known as N 290<sup>th</sup> Rd.*

and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.

The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.

IT IS THEREFOR ORDERED, ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN THE AFFIRMATIVE:

That the above described road, and every part hereof, should be vacated, and it is hereby vacated, as above described, and that the County Clerk enter the proceedings concerning said vacation upon the records, and that a copy thereof will be certified to the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Kansas.
