

FINAL RESOLUTION AND ORDER
RESOLUTION NO. 2021V-03

Now on this 25th day of October, 2021, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, Lincoln County, Kansas, all members of said board being present, the matter of the vacation of a certain road comes on for final hearing and order before said board.

After due consideration, and after being duly advised in the premises, the board finds that on the 11th day of October 2021, the said board did unanimously make a preliminary resolution, 2021R-02, proposing to vacate a certain road located in Golden Belt Township, as in their judgment said road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes said road has become practically impassable, and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair the said road or put the same in condition for public travel; the said road is described as follows:


Beginning at the NW corner of Section 15 also being the SW corner of Section 10 thence East one (1) mile to the NE corner of Section 15 also being the SE corner of Section 10 all being in Township 13 Range 9. Road right-of-way being 40 ft.


and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.

The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.


