CHARTER RESOLUTION NO. 2004-C01

A CHARTER RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 79-5022 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, CONCERNING SERVICE PROGRAMS FOR THE ELDERLY.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS:


Section 1. The County of Lincoln, Kansas by the power vested in it by K.S.A. 19-101a and K.S.A. 19-101b and as provided by K.S.A. 79-5036(b), hereby elects to exempt itself from the provisions of K.S.A. 79-5022.

Section 2. The following is hereby added to the provisions enabled by K.S.A. 79-5028 and amendments thereto: expenses incurred for the improvement, maintenance, regulation, expansion, and operation of Lincoln County service programs for the elderly, of up to one (1) mill, in addition to the existing authorization of up to one (1) mill, upon all taxable tangible property in the county in any given year, to be effective until said charter ordinance is rescinded by this Board or its successors.

Section 3. This Charter Resolution shall be published once each week for three consecutive weeks in the official county newspaper in compliance with K.S.A. 19-101b(c).

Section 4. This Charter Resolution shall be submitted to a referendum of the people in accordance with K.S.A. 19-101b(c) and shall become effective from and after certification of its passage by a majority of the electorate voting at the General Election to be held November 2, 2004, upon canvassing by the Board of County Commissioners on November 5, 2004.

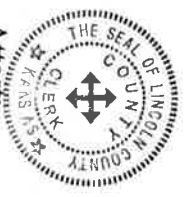
