

RESOLUTION 2010-15

WHEREAS, The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners did impose an emergency telephone tax pursuant to K.S.A. 12-5302, setting the amount of \$.75 per month per exchange access line or its equivalent; and,

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners finds that implementation of a "911" emergency system throughout the county is for the protection and preservation of the public health and welfare, and that there are not sufficient funds available to implement and maintain the same, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners finds that the tax is necessary to implement, operate and maintain the emergency telephone system; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners did establish a \$.75 per month per exchange access line or its equivalent tax on the 19th day of August, 1991, by Resolution 91-23; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-5303(c) the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners does hereby reset the emergency telephone tax at \$.75 per month per access line or its equivalent for the year of 2011, commencing January 1, 2011; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all provisions of Lincoln County Kansas, Resolution 91-23 are still in effect as set forth in that document.
