

FINAL RESOLUTION AND ORDER  
RESOLUTION NO. 2015V-02

Now on this 30th day of March, 2015, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, Lincoln County, Kansas, all members of said board being present, the matter of the vacation of a certain road comes on for final hearing and order before said board.

After due consideration, and after being duly advised in the premises, the board finds, that on the 16th day of March, 2015, the said board did unanimously make a preliminary resolution, 2015R-02, proposing to vacate certain roads located in Pleasant Township, as in their judgement said road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said roads or put the same in condition for public travel; said roads is described as follows:

Road 1:

That part of N 20<sup>th</sup> Rd between Section 31 and 32, Township 12S, Range 10W, beginning at the NE corner of Section 31 also being the NW corner of Section 32 thence South one mile to the SE corner of Section 31 also being the SW corner of Section 32, said right-of-way being 40 feet

Road 2:

That part of E Hawk Dr between Section 30 and 31, Township 12S, Range 10W beginning at the SE corner of the SW1/4 Section 30 also being the NE corner of the NW1/4 of Section 31 thence West ½ mile to the Lincoln/Russell County line and also that part 850 feet East of the SE corner of the SW1/4 of Section 30 also being the NE corner of the NW1/4 of Section 31, said right-of-way being 40 feet.


and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.


The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN THE AFFIRMATIVE: That the above described roads, and every part hereof, should be vacated, and is hereby vacated, as above described, and that the County Clerk enter the proceedings concerning said vacation upon the records, and that a copy thereof will be certified to the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Kansas.


