WHEREAS, a regional economic development organization, known as the North Central Regional Planning Commission, has been established; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Regional Planning Commission was formed in accordance to K.S.A. 12-716 et seq., now known as K.S.A. 12-744 et seq., in March 1972; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Regional Planning Commission has a membership representative of all geographic areas of Lincoln County; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Regional Planning Commission has a membership representative of all types of businesses and industry residents in Lincoln County; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners is represented on the Board of Directors of the North Central Regional Planning Commission;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS: That the North Central Regional Planning Commission meets the requirements of K.S.A. 74-50,116(c)(1); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Kansas Secretary of Commerce is hereby requested to acknowledge the North Central Regional Planning Commission as a qualifying regional economic development organization for the purpose of re-approving Lincoln County as a designated nonmetropolitan business region.


