

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

November 2, 2015

- Call to Order:** The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the commission meeting room of the courthouse Monday, November 2, 2015. Vice-Chairman Al Joe Wallace called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Member Terry Finch present. Chairman Gerald Huehl was absent. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.
- Visitors:** Others present for portions of the meeting: Mike Weigel, Dustin Florence, Michel O'Hare, and Robert Howe.
- Law Enforcement:** Sheriff Mike Weigel with Undersheriff Dustin Florence reported that Clinton Bailey has completed KLETC and is now a certified law enforcement officer and requested a fifty cent per hour merit increase. Terry Finch moved to grant Clinton Bailey a fifty cent per hour merit increase for becoming a certified law enforcement officer, effective October 26, 2015, seconded by Al Joe Wallace. Motion carried.
- Highway Department:** Director of Public Works Michel O'Hare with Road and Bridge Supervisor Robert Howe reported on highway department projects. O'Hare presented a gravel agreement for the board's approval. Al Joe Wallace moved to enter into a one-year gravel removal/purchase agreement with Barbara Holmes, expiring November 1, 2016, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried. O'Hare discussed OS 45 bridge replacement project and the acquisition of road right-of-way, forwarding a request from Gary Pepper. The board denied the request as it would not be financially feasible to the county.
- Minutes Approved:** Terry Finch moved to approve and adopt the minutes of the October 26, 2015 and October 30, 2015 regular meetings as presented, seconded by Al Joe Wallace. Motion carried.
- Meeting Time Changed:** The board approved changing the meeting times from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. beginning with the December 7, 2015 meeting.
- Adjourn:** With no further business to come before the board the chairman adjourned the meeting at 11:36 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. Monday, November 9, 2015 in the commission meeting room of the courthouse.
